Dear Friends,

A Bible passage we had in Church a few weeks ago finishes with an acclamation by those who saw Jesus in action. The people who witnessed Jesus at work were filled with awe and praised God.

Then we read the closing words of Luke 7:16

"God has come to help His people."

Jesus was a person who believed and lived out the saying that "Actions speak louder than words." The Bible calls on Christians and all people of goodwill to be doers rather than just speakers or hearers of the Word. There's a lovely new song by Vicky Beeching that includes the words...

Break our hearts

With the things that break Yours

And send us out to shine in the darkness

It's time for us to live the songs we sing

And turn our good intentions into action

To bring the kind of worship you desire

And move beyond our self-absorbed distractions.

In that Bible reading from Luke, Jesus has just raised back to life a young man who had died. It's a very moving moment, and one in which Jesus is recorded as speaking only ten words. But what He says, and what He does, fills the people with awe. It really is a life changing event, for the new life given to the young man points us to where Jesus always wants us to direct our gaze - the hope of heaven - but not so that we lose our sense of responsibility to others here on earth.

The resurrection of Jesus Himself should lead His followers to do everything we possibly can to bring further justice to the Third World and seek to 'combat' with all our might racism, poverty, homelessness, and every other kind of evil and injustice that exists. Resurrection now is precisely about how Christians, in and under God's power, should be at the forefront of getting rid of it. We will have to abandon that 'what's in it for me' agenda in favour of the 'what will bring more of God's justice to the poor' agenda. This is the Jesus way - few words - great actions.
