LENT 2018

From the earliest days, Lent has been a season of self-examination, reflection, prayer in preparation for the great festival of Easter; a time when people have traditionally undertaken some kind of discipline to assist them in their journey through this holy season. In light of this, I hope to draw your attention to some of the options we are making available. I invite you to engage with them and hope you will find them helpful.

It has been a custom to undertake some kind of reading or study so we are delighted to offer this years **Lent Course**. '*Live Lent: let your light shine*', is recommended by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York. It will be run on Saturday afternoons at St Nicholas' Church, Broadway at 3pm starting 17th February. Please contact Philip for more details.

The diocese has compiled a booklet of daily readings and reflections which can be used during Lent. These booklets entitled **Praying Together** are available free of charge in all our churches and I encourage you to take one (and one for anybody you know who may benefit from them) to use.

We continue to offer **Morning Prayer** six days a week at St Nicholas' Church in Broadway at 9am. Used by Anglicans throughout the world, it is a wonderful time to join our prayers with those of so many around the world.

Christian Meditation continues to be run in conjunction with The Convent of Mercy every Thursday evening at the Vicarage at 7pm.

The Vigil Office takes place every Saturday evening at St Nicholas' Broadway at **6pm** – a wonderful way to prepare Sunday's Eucharist. The office is followed by a brief Communion service which is optional but useful to those who may not be able to attend on Sunday.
