LENT 2018

From the earliest days, Lent has been a season of self-examination, reflection, prayer in preparation for the great festival of Easter; a time when people have traditionally undertaken some kind of discipline to assist them in their journey through this holy season. In light of this, I hope to draw your attention to some of the options we are making available. I invite you to engage with them and hope you will find them helpful.

It has been a custom to undertake some kind of reading or study so we are delighted to offer this year's **Lent Course**. '*Live Lent: let your light shine*', is recommended by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York. It will be run on Saturday afternoons at St Nicholas' Church, Broadway at 3pm starting 17th February. The diocese has compiled a booklet of daily readings and reflections which can be used during Lent. These booklets entitled **Praying Together** are available free of charge in all our churches and I encourage you to take one (and one for anybody you know who may benefit from them) to use.
