LENT 2018

From the earliest days, Lent has been a season of self-examination, reflection, prayer in preparation for the great festival of Easter; a time when people have traditionally undertaken some kind of discipline to assist them in their journey through this holy season. In light of this, I hope to draw your attention to some of the options we are making available. I invite you to engage with them and hope you will find them helpful.

It has been a custom to undertake some kind of reading or study so we are delighted to offer this year's **Lent Course**. *'Live Lent: let your light shine'*, is recommended by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York. It will be run on Saturday afternoons at St Nicholas' Church, Broadway at 3pm starting 17th February. Please contact Philip for more details.

The diocese has compiled a booklet of daily readings and reflections which can be used during Lent. These booklets entitled **Praying Together** are available free of charge in all our churches and I encourage you to take one (and one for anybody you know who may benefit from them) to use.
